Gangsters Vimalabai, Sunil Rathod surrender after stern police warning

Duo give up after SP H D Anand Kumar warned Chadachan family of seizing their assets

AFTER Superintendent of Police H D Anand Kumar warned the Chadachan family of seizing their assets if they failed to surrender, Vimalabai Chadachan and her aide Sunil Rathod appeared before the District Sessions Court on Tuesday.



Vimalabai Chadachan, one of the gangsters of Bheema River bank, has surrendered before the court on Tuesday.

The duo was sent to judicial custody. Chadachan family is one of the notorious gangs of Bheema River bank in the district.

Vimalabai, who is a wife of most wanted criminal Mallikarjun Chadachan, faces criminal charges in at least eight cases.

She had gone underground after a group of criminals had attacked Mahadeva Sahukar Byragonda, who is another gangster in Bheema River bank

aides connected to this case. A couple of weeks ago, the SP Anand Kumar had warned that the police department would seize all their assets if they failed to turn up either before the police or court.

Speaking to the reporters, SP Anand Kumar said, "With regard to the attack on gangster Byragonda and eight other cases, Mallikarjun Chadachan and his family members and aides had gone underground. An effort is being made to nab them. As a part of the investigations, two teams were working extensively in Pune to arrest the main accused Mallikarjun Chadachan."

"After we were making preparations to seize the properties of the Chadachan family, Vimalabai and his aide surrendered before the court. They

have been sent to judicial custody. If necessary, we will take both into custody for investigation in the coming days. Meanwhile, Mallikarjun and another accused, who supplied arms, are absconding and efforts are being made to arrest them too," stated SP Kumar.

It may be recalled that the district police allegedly conspiring with Byragonda, had encountered history-shetter Dharmaraj Chadachan and his brother Gangadhar Chadachan, the sons of Mallikarjun and Vimalabai, in a reported fake encounter in 2017. In order to avenge the deaths of their children, Mallikarjun allegedly planned an attack on Byragonda in 2020. In the attack, Byragonda was injured severely after being hit by three bullets from the rival gang.

GADAG: Retired soldiers in Shirol village of Gadag district have come together to train youths who aspire to join the security forces and recent military recruitment scheme, Agnipath. Their aim is to push more youths from the rural parts of Gadag into the Indian military establishments.

The initiative started with social activities in Shirol village by the Youth Sainik Friends Association (YSFA), set up by retired soldiers. Rain wreaks havoc in undivided Ballari dist

HEAVY rainfall is lashing Ballari district and in separate incidents, two persons were reportedly washed away in flooding streams. These incidents were reported from Siruguppa and Sandur taluks on Tuesday night.

In case of an emergency, the public can call Ballari DC's office at 08392277100.

Due to continuous rain in the past two days, as many as 39 houses have collapsed and 200 are partially damaged. Most of the streams, rivers, and lakes are in spate. Over 20,000 hectares of crops were lost due to heavy rain in the undivided Ballari district.

Two persons lost their lives while they tried to cross flooding water bodies. In an incident near Ravari village of Siruguppa taluk, a truck was stuck in a stream as he tried to cross over it.

The truck driver asked for help by standing on the truck but the cleaner was washed away. Details of the cleaner are yet to be ascertained. In another incident, 63-year-old Krishna Kumar, a resident of Bommaghatta village in Sandur taluk was washed away while he tried to cross a stream. The death toll due to rain in the undivided Ballari district has gone up to three.
