This booklet contains details pertaining to various aspects of the online examination you are going to take and important instructions about related matters. **The answers will be indicated online, hence you should carefully read instructions regarding the method of indicating answers.** You are advised to study this booklet carefully as it will help you in preparing for the examination.

Before appearing for the online examination you should strictly ensure yourself that you fulfill the eligibility criteria stipulated in the advertisement in all respects.

Please note that since this is a competitive examination, mere passing is not adequate. You have to obtain a high rank in the order of merit to get eligibility for future selection process. You should, therefore, put in best efforts in the examination.

- All students must carry/Keep their original Government Id proof with them for attempting the assessment.
- Candidates will be asked to present that in front of the camera at the time of login and during the entire assessment duration.
- Place your mobile phone in a way that your face is captured during the entire assessment duration.
- Get ready at least half an hour before the assessment.
- Check if your device/smart mobile is working properly.
- Ensure stable internet connection during the assessment.
- Create a quiet and comfortable environment to take the assessment.
- Read and follow all the instructions carefully before starting the assessment.
- Keep your power bank handy if required to charge your device.
- Manage your time to attempt all the questions within the given time.
- Call on the candidate support number from another mobile phone in case you are not able to login.

Don'ts:

- Do not use any unethical means to attempt the assessment. Assessment will be disqualified at any stage if you are found guilty.
- Do not ignore the instructions before proceeding.
- You will not be able to login once the time gets expired.
- You are not allowed to move during the assessment.
- No bio breaks are allowed during the assessment.
- Assessment cannot be organized if the device/smart mobile is not connected with Internet & enabled to Web Camera/Front Camera
